- You are wearing a coat that extends below your knees.
- You are wearing a coat that is intended for outdoor wear (as determined by the CWHS staff's discretion).

Student Parking: All student drivers must register their cars and pay \$15 to receive a parking space in the student lot. Automobile registration forms can be found on the District website and in the High School office. These forms and the fee must be turned into Mrs. Prohaska, room C210, before 7:30 AM or during PLT.

This year spots are assigned on a first come, first serve basis, starting with our seniors. Seniors may begin registering for their spots on Monday, August 29th through Thursday, September 1st. Any other eligible driver will be able to register for a spot starting on Tuesday, September 6th.

After Monday, September 12th you must be registered to park if you drive to school. If you are not you will receive consequences and fines for parking without being registered.
