Kindergarten Enrollment

We will begin Kindergarten enrollment on:

Monday, February 25th

You may pick up an enrollment packet in the office. Please remember that we must have a copy of your child's birth certificate, *proof of residence, social security card and immunization record in order to enroll him/her in school.

The new law requires that children must be 5 on or before September 1, 2019 to enroll in Kindergarten. If your child will turn 5 between Sep 2nd and Dec. 2nd, your child will be in a Transitional Kindergarten classroom.
***PG&E, water bill or mortgage/rental agreement are required as proof of residence.**
