RULES AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. The student must be at least 15 years of age and not older than 20. He or she must be a 2023 graduating high school senior who will receive a diploma from Oakesdale high school. He or she must be accepted for admission to an accredited college or university matriculating in 2023.
2. Each student must submit a fully completed and signed application. Failure to follow instructions can result in disqualification.
3. Students must submit the following:
 - a. Completed and signed application
 - b. Essay (typed)
 - c. Proof of enrollment in high school via an official transcript sent by the high school, (if transcripts cannot be provided, alternate means of proving enrollment will be accepted on an individual basis)
 - d. Proof of acceptance to a trade school, college or university (letter acceptable)
4. All materials (including essays) become property of Oakesdale Fire Department. By submitting an application and essay, the student grants permission to publish any and all essays.
5. Awards are based on a combination of academic achievement, national test scores, extracurricular participation and the essay. All decisions are final. The scoring is based on the following:

1. Grade Point Average	20 points
2. SAT or ACT scores	20 points
3. Essay	20 points
4. Academic prizes, awards, hobbies, School and outside extracurricular activities	20 points
5. Community Service	20 points
Total	100 points

WRITING SAMPLE/ESSAY

On a separate sheet or sheets of paper, write a 200-300 word essay that explains **“What It Means to ME to volunteer within our community”**. Please be original, creative and use proper spelling, grammar and punctuation. (Only writing samples that are typed will be considered).

- Student's Essay (typed)
- Official high school transcript
- Proof of acceptance to an accredited college or university
