

**Barneveld School District
School Board Inservice Training**

The Barneveld Board believes that in-service training for its members is vital in order for the Board to govern the school district in the most informed and prudent manner possible. Recognizing the importance of keeping current with educational issues, the Board encourages board members to attend training sessions, educational workshops and conferences throughout their term of service. These meetings include sessions on such topics as school board responsibilities, legislation and school law, curriculum, finance, teacher recruitment and evaluation, and board policy formulation etc.

The Board shall pay reasonable attendance fees, shall reimburse attending Board members for travel outside the district, and other necessary expenses. Actual expenses will be reimbursed upon presentation of receipts/documentation. Expenses incurred with no receipt will be paid according to rates and procedures established at the Annual meeting or for district staff members.

The District Administrator will report monthly on upcoming in-service opportunities for Board members. The Board may select representatives to these sessions from among its membership.

The Barneveld School Board encourages all school board members to obtain points in WASB's Board Member Recognition Point System.
