RE: **UAV Ground & Flight School**

On March 13, 14, and 15, the East Central Educational Service Center in Connersville will facilitate a UAV Ground & Flight School for prospective UAV pilots. This class is open to all who need the Part 107 license to be "legal" to fly drones as part of their employment, including but not limited to real estate agents, photographers, surveyors, high school STEM and college instructors, farmers, firemen, police officers, landscape architects, homeland security officials, and school/public building inspectors.

Dave Sell, experienced NASA Aerospace and Technical Specialist and UAV certified pilot, will be the instructor. Content will include four 90-minute sessions in Ground School and two 90-minute sessions in Flight School. All sessions will take place at the Service Center in Connersville. Dave will share details about test sites and dates during the training. The official Part 107 FAA ruling and remote pilot knowledge test prep information can be found at https://www.faa.gov/uas/getting_started/.

Please circulate this memo and flyer to anyone who may be interested in the UAV course. Class size is limited to 20 people so plan to register as soon as possible. Participants will be invoiced after the first training day.
