I would like to start with an important message from Dr. Leggett:

Hello PES Parents and Guardians,

At this year's School Board retreat, we had an in-depth discussion about the FAST program, specifically if it's continuing to provide everything our school intends for this type of activity. Based on community and Board input over the past few years, our goals for FAST are as follows:

- Helping students develop a sense of place here in the Upper Valley
- Exploration of activities & hobbies
- An opportunity to come together as a community
- Support of community partners

In essence, it boiled down to a desire for activities where the whole school takes part to enjoy something unique to our community or region.

The Board also discussed some of the frustration and unpredictability with FAST in recent years, especially due to weather and other factors outside of our control.

This led us to the idea of potentially make a change to three full days (one in each of fall, winter, and spring) of outdoor NH community events where all students and staff at PES connect. An example of this for winter might look like a "Winter Wonderland" day, during which all of PES learn new outdoor snow and ice activities together.

We recognize that FAST - and skiing in particular - is a long-standing tradition at PES, one where a lot of great friendships, experiences, and a love of NH winters were born. We'd love to have your feedback as we look to the future:

- 1. Should FAST continue as is, for five weeks of afternoon winter activities programming for students and families?
- 2. Should we work with Whaleback and/or the town recreation program to offer skiing as an after-school activity?
- 3. Should we simply allow families to decide on this type of experience on their own, outside of the school day?

The Board will be discussing these options and listening to suggestions at their upcoming meeting on Tuesday June 13, 2023 at 5:30 pm. We hope to hear your ideas on this during public input at the beginning of the meeting -- you can join in person in the Music Room or via zoom.
