EQUIVALENCE IN CURRICULUM MATERIALS AND INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPLIES

The Monroe County Board of Education believes that curricular materials and instructional supplies appropriate to the needs of the school program must be available to each student and teacher. Available system resources will be allocated to schools on an equitable basis, recognizing system policies and local school needs. To this end, the superintendent and program directors will allocate qualifying programmatic funds on a per student basis, prorated according to student population in each school.

All students in the county are granted equal access to county adopted textbooks, required curricular material, transportation, food service and county programs for any particular grade span. Classrooms may vary as to materials and equipment. This will come about due to a particular school's choice on how funds are spent to meet strategic and student needs.

Teachers and administrators will be assisted in their tasks by other professional resource persons bringing their particular background to bear on curriculum concerns, educational procedures and individual student needs.
