STUDENT TEACHING AND INTERNSHIPS

Pursuant to the State Board of Education regulation that requires teacher training colleges to contract with county boards of education to provide facilities and supervising teachers for students taking practice teaching, the Monroe County Board of Education, due to limitation of facilities, has adopted the following guidelines to govern the handling of practice teaching in the schools of the county:

- 1.0 First priority will be given Monroe County students. All bona-fide residents of Monroe County who are enrolled in any teacher training college in the state will be accepted.
- 2.0 Second priority will be given to West Virginia students who reside outside of Monroe County. These students from any teacher training college in the state will be accepted if facilities are available after Monroe County students are accommodated.
- 3.0 Third priority will be given to students whose home residence is outside the state. These students from any teacher training college in the state will be accepted if facilities are available after students from Monroe County and other counties in the state are accommodated.
- 4.0 Students must be of good moral character.
- 5.0 Students must conform to manner of dress and conduct required of Monroe County teachers and students.
- 6.0 Students must conform to requirements of the West Virginia State Board of Education on the placement of practice teachers.
