PCCS features multi-age classrooms, portfolio assessments, outdoor adventure, service learning and character education.

The Pocatello Community Charter School is a K-8 charter school serving 350 students in southeastern Idaho. The small city of Pocatello is located just a few hours from Grand Teton National Park, Yellowstone National Park, Sun Valley, Jackson Hole, and Salt Lake City.
