Release of Students

Teachers and Principals have the responsibility and custody of all the children enrolled in school. Be very sure that it is the wish of the legal parent or guardian to have the child released during school hours. **Never release a child to anyone until the parent has been contacted.**

Discipline

General Statement:

The policy in the Garden Valley Schools is to provide school conditions, conduct student operations, and develop relationships between teachers and pupils, and among pupils that contribute to orderly operations with as much freedom of expression and activity as will be conducive to the growth of individual responsibilities and self discipline.

Teachers must maintain appropriate discipline in their classroom. These actions need to be based on the District Philosophy that is centered around the well being of the individual child in a caring environment. When confronted by the immature, non-cooperative child, teachers will need to call upon their special skills and strategies to deal with these non-conforming students.

It is expected that teachers will maintain discipline by use best practices for classroom management when establishing discipline procedures.
