Immunization Requirements

2021-2022 School Year

A valid South Carolina Certificate of Immunization for all enrolled children must be maintained by public schools for grades 5K through 12th and child development programs under the control of Department of Education, (as defined in SC Code of Laws Section 63-13-20).

South Carolina state law requires a valid SC Certificate of Immunization or valid exemption. Children without a valid certificate or exemption will not be allowed to attend childcare and/or school.

Please access the information links or scan code for specific immunization (shot) requirements for your child's grade level.

General Information:

- Ask your child's doctor about the vaccine shots your child needs for school entry if you are unsure.
- Obtain a new South Carolina Certificate of Immunization every time your child gets a vaccine shot.
- Give a copy of the new South Carolina Certificate of Immunization to your child's school nurse.
- Note-If your child is attending CCDD Virtual Academy, he/she will still need to be in compliance with the grade level, age appropriate immunizations. Your child's school nurse will need to receive a copy of a current, valid SC Certificate of Immunization on your child.
- Students enrolled in grades 4K to 12th must be up-to-date on the following shots based on their grade level:
 - Hepatitis A
 - Hepatitis B
 - DTaP (tetanus, whooping cough)
 - Polio
 - MMR (measles, mumps, rubella)
 - Varicella (chickenpox)
 - Tdap (whooping cough booster required before seventh grade)
 - Hib (haemophilus influenza Type b)
 - PCV3-(pneumococcal)
