What Parents Need to Know About HPV

- The HPV vaccine is FDA-approved and extremely safe and effective.
- The HPV vaccine is for both boys and girls. The optimal age for the first dose is 11–12, but it can be given as early as 9.
- Your child only needs 2 doses if vaccination is initiated before age 15.
- The HPV vaccine is long lasting and protects against 6 types of cancer.
