In those instances where a "fair-use" or evaluation period has been established, tapes made of broadcasts may not be kept or used beyond the established "fair-use" or evaluation period. All videos and disks will be inventoried in the library periodically throughout the year and will be erased if beyond the "fair-use" or evaluation period.

Any M.S.A.D. #49 employee requesting or making a copy of copyrighted materials will accept sole responsibility for compliance with United States Copyright Laws. M.S.A.D. #49 will defend an employee in a court action only when he/she has complied with the law and board policy. Anyone who strays the policy is on his/her own if a lawsuit results.
