Kyle was an avid sports fan and a successful student athlete. Kyle played football at William Jewell College in Liberty, Missouri. He was always willing to step in wherever he was needed and believed in working hard, being competitive and always displaying good sportsmanship. After losing Kyle much too early on December 1, 2013, family and friends have searched for ways to honor his memory.

To commemorate his life and to ensure he will continue his legacy of helping others, the "Kyle VanWinkle Memorial Scholarship" was established. - You plan on attending an accredited college or university beginning the Fall Semester of 2022 as a full time freshman student-athlete.
