WHO MAY APPLY:

Any graduating Senior who has attended Smithville High School for the last four semesters and is planning to further his/her education in a two-year or four-year college.

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

The selection committee shall be made up of one Kiwanis member, one Rotary Club member, one member of the current Smithville R-II Board of Education, and the current Principal of Smithville High School.

PRESENTATION OF SCHOLARSHIP:

The scholarship will be awarded on awards night of Smithville High School and will be presented by the high school principal or the high school counselor.
