SCHOOL CLOSURES

First, I want to thank our community and parents of the Smithville School District for their support! With districts closing their doors around us for short periods of time to manage the high volume of staff absences I wanted to provide you with an update regarding our status in this regard.

I look at two data points on a daily basis, the staff absence fill rate and student attendance. The fill rate tells me the percentage of positions where a substitute has been secured. Secondly, our student absences give me some insight as to the health of our student population. While we are taking a hit in these areas, it is not devastating at this point.

While I do not anticipate having to close our doors I understand our situation could turn south at any given time. Again, we will continue to evaluate our situation and our options if our absences threaten our ability to safely have school.

I am grateful and pleased with our ability to manage our absences thus far and obviously everyone's desire would be to keep our doors open. Thank you to our substitute teachers, administrators, teachers, and staff for all that you are doing to help make this happen!
