

Dear Marauders:

We know the past few weeks have been trying in terms of snow days and ice days. We have already used 14 days and the State allows us 6 forgiven days. We have applied for a waiver for an additional 3 forgiven days, but that still leaves us with many make up days.

Fortunately, this year we have built in some opportunities for us to make up those days without having to go too far into the summer. A survey of our staff showed that over 70% of our staff preferred to make up some of these days this Friday and Monday (originally scheduled as days off for “mid-winter” break) and 90% also chose to have half of a day of school on Good Friday.

With the forecasted weather this week, we are surely to encounter further snow days. Thus, Ovid-Elsie Area Schools will plan on the following:

Friday, February 15th – full day of school for staff and students

Monday, February 18th – full day of school for staff and students

Friday, April 19th – half day of school for staff and students.

While we understand that this may be an inconvenience for some, we are working together to try to ensure that our students get the maximum number of educational days.
