- **Need not be Italian to apply;** and
- Application/materials must be submitted on or before **(Monday, April 25, 2022)**
- No deferring scholarship; only eligible for first year of college that begins 2022.

2022 ITALIAN-AMERICAN WOMEN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

This year the Italian-American Women's Club from Madison, Wisconsin, will award:

Two (\$1,000) -- Italian-American Women's Club Scholarship

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Be a senior (male or female) in a Wisconsin high school.
2. Intend to enroll in a course of at least two years duration at a college, university, or technical school with the objective of securing a degree in advance of a high school diploma.
3. Intend to enroll as a full-time student.
4. Must be interested in Italian culture.
5. **Need not be Italian to apply.**
6. Applications shall be submitted to the Italian-American Women's Club Scholarship Committee on or before Monday, April 25, 2022.
7. **No deferring scholarship; only eligible for first year of college that begins 2022.**

BASIS OF AWARD

The Italian-American Women's Club Scholarships will be awarded to students based upon the following criteria:

- Scholastic ability.
- Financial need.
- Contributions of the applicant to the community (school, town, or other communities).
- Personal recommendations from adults who know your work/experience/education.
- Essay that includes why the applicant is interested in Italian culture.

PROCEDURE

1. The application, a copy of your latest high school transcript, and two letters of recommendation are to be **received by the IAWC Scholarship Chairperson on or before Monday, April 25, 2022 (postmarked).**
2. The Italian-American Women's Club Scholarship Committee will review applications and make the selections.
3. Determination of the awards will be the sole discretion of the Italian-American Women's Club Scholarship Committee. A member of the IAWC who has a relative applying for this scholarship will not participate on the Scholarship Committee.
4. Two (\$1,000) scholarships will be awarded.
5. Entire Scholarship will be awarded for 2022, in full, once proof of enrollment has been received.
