

SKYWARD FAMILY ACCESS


The Wisconsin Heights School District utilizes a web-based service called Family Access through Skyward that allows parents/guardians to view attendance records, schedules, food service balances, discipline issues, grades, and missing work/assignments.

Calendar	← District Calendar.
Gradebook	← Shows any missing assignments and current grades if posted for classes. Grades posted to the report card will be in bold .
Attendance	← Shows your child's absences and tardy history.
Student Info	← Here you will be able to view your child's student information such as student demographics, student school ID number, school, grade, teacher and emergency contacts.
Food Service	← Here you can check your food service balance, make a payment set purchase limit and view purchases made by your student.
Schedule	← Your child's current class schedule.
Discipline	← Shows any discipline offenses found
Fee Management	← This shows you any unpaid balances for fees and your paid fees history. You can also click on “Make a Payemnt”
Report Cards	← MS/HS students - view report cards.
Skylert	← Skylert enables you to receive notifications concerning your child(ren). You have control over some of the notifications to receive
Health Info	← This will show you your child's health information including health conditions, allergies to medicine, injuries, vaccinations, etc.
Login History	← Shows when you last logged into Skyward and what areas.

Once you have set up your Family Access account, you will see the "home" page. Any messages or notifications will be displayed in the middle and any upcoming events on the right hand side.

Riding Bikes in P.E. Mon Sep 12, 2016 8:09pm

What you need to know up front:
Mr Fester's 7th and 8th grade classes will be riding bikes in P.E. Starting Wed Sept 14- 22nd
Mrs. Rennicke's 7th and 8th grade classes Friday Sept 23rd - 30th

1. All students must wear a helmet when riding a bike.
2. Students may bring their own Helmets to use in P.E. Class.
3. Students may bring their own bike to use in P.E. class provided the bikes are Safe and "Operationally Sound" (tires hold air, brakes work correctly, Drive train works correctly)
4. Students may leave their bike at school if needed, and helmet can be kept in the gym locker if it isn't needed for riding home.
5. Instruction will be differentiated to accommodate skills of beginner and intermediate riders.

The school owns 18 bikes for students to use in class and an ample supply of helmets for the students to use.
