Michelle Brokes discussed possible options going forward which included the following: for Central Plains students – grades PreK through 3<sup>rd</sup> at CPES-Holyrood; grades 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> at CPMS – Bushton and grades 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> to CPHS – Claflin. She also discussed the possibility of keeping everything the same, which would lead to staff cuts along with program cuts, which would directly affect the students.

Discussion on the 2019-2020 school year

Tony Zink discussed possibly keeping an attendance center open in each community – Wilson, Bushton, Holyrood and Claflin, but this would also lead to staff cuts and possible cuts to student programs. He also discussed moving 7th and 8th grade students from Bushton to Claflin and 4th grade students from Holyrood to Bushton.

Discussion (cont)

By consensus, the board agreed that no attendance center will be closed for the 2019-2020 school year.

Consensus Agreement

Mr. Clark shared some of the projected figures for budget cuts at Wilson and Central Plains schools.

The board also discussed that if the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students were moved to CPHS – Claflin, that their athletic activities (practice and games) could still continue at Bushton.

Discuss 7th & 8th activities at Bushton

On motion by Tony Zink and seconded by Jacob Charvat, the board voted 7-0 to go into Executive Session at 7:30 p.m. for 20 minutes, to include Greg Clark and John Sherman, to discuss personnel issues and staffing for the 2019-2020 school year, pursuant to the non-elected personnel exception under KOMA, and return to open meeting at 7:50 p.m.

The board further discussed the following: making the budget cuts that would least impact the students; cuts that will impact staff; and reviewing all the changes and recommendations that were discussed over the last several months.

4<sup>th</sup> grade students from Holyrood to Bushton, which will then become an intermediate school for grades 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup>; continue with 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade activities and athletics at Bushton; and instructing the administration to make recommendations for staffing. Jerry Bieberle voted no.
