Their concerns included the following: loss of students for Option 3; difference in total savings' numbers; cuts across the district; consolidation and joining high schools; closing a school would be a community loss; what's best for students; cost to educate students by building; aspect of north vs south; Option 3 is not needed; HVAC system to fail completely; fear of change; petition for Option 3; money management; committee to help with finances; failure of bond issue; consider all options; consolidation; and losing students at Wilson.
