The Arc of Bristol County provides a variety of resources and supports to individuals and their families. Our team of staff works with each person to understand their needs, as well as, to provide individualized supports that will be meaningful to them.

## Services available throughout Bristol County include:

**Adult Family Care** is a service funded through MassHealth. It is considered a residential option in which a caregiver (family or non-family member) who lives in the home receives a stipend for the daily care that they provide.

**Adult Services** including **Individual Supports** which provide services to individuals in their own homes and **Project Rec-Connect** which provides an opportunity for individuals to experience events and socialize with their peers and **Shared Living** which matches an individual with a provider (non-family) so that they can live in a family style model of support.

**Day Habilitation Services** located in Middleboro and Attleboro - The Arc of Bristol County's Day Habilitation Program offers Individuals with disabilities the opportunity to choose a community based model of supports directed by the participants and implemented by a dedicated interdisciplinary team of professionals who align themselves with the goals of each individual and work together to seek out the most creative and meaningful ways to make them a reality.

**Family Support Services** including **Service Navigation** which provide families with comprehensive information, support, referrals and resources. **Support Groups** offer parents the opportunity to share and listen to other families who are or have gone through the adult transition period. Our **Autism Now Center** is pleased to offer individuals with Autism and their families ABA services, parent workshops, IEP clinics and a sensory room for all ages to explore. **Educational Advocacy** assists parents in being their own best advocate for their child or teenager.

**Trust Management** With several estate planning options available, there is no "one size fits all" in assessing the needs for your own and the future of your loved one. The Arc of Bristol County will provide a comprehensive personalized plan by working directly with individuals and families.
