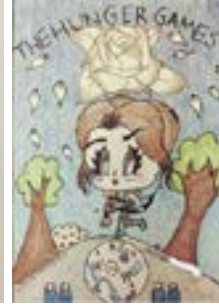

4-H LEGO Robotics

(Introductory level)

4-H has developed a comprehensive robotics program to inspire young people and develop an early interest in robotics engineering and technology. We are excited to team up with HBC Community Education to offer 4-H LEGO Robotics again! Since this class has been so popular in the past, we have decided to offer two sessions. 4-H Robotics is for youth in 4th and 5th grade who have NOT previously attended a 4-H LEGO Robotics class. Class size limited to 12 people per session. See below to learn more and register!



4-H LEGO ROBOTICS WILL CONSIST OF: Learning and building robots using LEGO Mindstorm NXT kits and using the computer to program them to complete mazes, obstacles and other challenges!

SCHEDULE: Session 1: Tuesdays & Thursdays for 3 weeks beginning March 12. (March 12, 14, 19, 21, 26, 28) Session 2: Tuesdays & Thursdays for 3 weeks beginning April 15. *4-H LEGO Robotics will start at 3:20 p.m. and finish at 4:50 p.m.

SWIMMING LESSONS 2019

Parents:

As part of the Physical Education curriculum at H-BC Elementary, students take swimming lessons at the Rock County Pool in Luverne. This year, American Red Cross swimming lessons will be offered to students in grades 3-6. Students will have 9 lessons from **March 11 until March 21**.

Lessons are 45 minutes in length each day. The following is the basic schedule for the lessons:

- 3rd and 4th grade will leave from Beaver Creek at 12:20 and swim from 12:45-1:30
- 5th grade will leave from Beaver Creek at 1:20 and swim from 1:45-2:30
- 6th grade will leave from Hills at 1:15 and swim from 1:45-2:30

All instructors are certified water safety instructors. Each student will be learning at his/her own level. We believe swimming is a recreational sport that can be enjoyed over a lifetime.

We are pleased to be able to provide these lessons for a cost of **\$20.00** per student. The school district and H-BC PTO will pick up the remaining costs involved. No student will be excluded for financial reasons. If the \$20.00 cost is a hardship for you, please contact Mr. Phelps. Your child will still be able to participate.

Visor/Cap Sizes

How to find head circumference: Place a string or tape around your head about 1/8" above your ear, across the mid-forehead, completely circling your head. Hold the tape firmly, but not too tightly. Basically you need to measure your head exactly where the hat will sit. If your measurement falls between sizes, choose the next largest size.
