- L. ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS
- 1. Elementary Principal Mr. Routhier. The Mstep testing is still going 4th and 5th are finished start 3 and 6th this week. Its a real process right now. We are working hard to make our way thru it. Kindergarten round up was held and we are looking at a class of 30 at this point. May 6th we held aces last week. Also last week we did the science fair and art fair so that turned out really well. Assessment tomorrow its called the TIMS, and we are volunteering for this, its the two areas of math and science. It will be the 4th grade that will participate. As the school winds down there are some field trips going on and then the awards assembly. New math textbook series, so they are looking at the common core and our text are outdated. Got two quotes so far but they are not cheap so going to look at it again. So, next month we will look at that in detail.
- 2. Middle School/High School Principal Mr. Reattoir Friday night at 7 and then graduation at 12:30. Will have a little bit of jog around due to the hallway. Let Brian know if you are not coming. Seniors are taking exams and finishing up. Scheduling is in full run and it's coming together. The art and spring concert went really well. The MITES competition produced 3 in the top 10. Mstep for middle and high school is done, they all left today. It is a tedious process. Track came in second so far and eight of them will go to kingsford for the finals. Baseball and softball start districts already, so good luck to all them.

3. Superintendent - Mr. Kantola-purchased business services the person that was here, is leaving so we have replacements here until they fill that job. School aid bill was supposed to be done looking at 70\$ per pupil increase but it could be higher. There were 30 districts that received a perfect financial indicator score and Brimley was one of them! Bring your expense forms next meeting. the negotiations team needs to meet to discuss the superintendent and assistant principal. that will be May 27th at 6 p.m. update on hallway and roof.....for both projects the roof and the entrances...the insurance will cover the roof and not the entrance. we have a temporary permit to brace and so forth and that is only good for 180 days. This will start next week. Our engineers believe that the report provided by the state inspector are incorrect. The state inspector indicates a problem with soil, compaction, and foundation issues. So, we are continuing to fight this issue. The engineer will meet with the state and go over the findings.
