

**KIWANIS CITIZENSHIP AWARD**  
**Applications Due April 29, 2019**



Each year the Kiwanis Club of Dayton awards a Citizenship Award in the amount of \$500 to at least one Dayton High School graduating senior boy and girl or past Citizenship Award winners who meet the application criteria. The award winners must intend to pursue post-high school training and meet the standards set forth by the governing committee of Kiwanis.

The scholarship award is used to acknowledge a high standard of character and principles of good citizens at school, in home and community. The winning applicants are judged based upon evidence of character and citizenship, which they exhibit.

Areas included in the consideration are as follows:

**Character and Citizenship:**

1. Courtesy
2. High Standard of Moral Character
3. Good Conduct
4. Honesty
5. Positive Attitude
6. Community Service

**Scholarship:**

Each candidate must have a grade point average acceptable for entrance to a post-high school institution of his/her choice.

**Activities:**

The student participates in a moderate, well-balanced program of school and community service activities.

**Application:**

Any graduating member of the Dayton High School senior class or eligible former recipient may complete the following application packet and turn in to Jana Eaton in the Administration office. The application should include the following:

1. A letter of application that includes a list of major activities, honors and achievements, GPA and an outline of future plans including why he or she wants to further their education.
2. Reference statements from at least three supportive and interested adults.

**Payment of Award:**

The award will be paid to the post-high school institution of the student's choice. It will be paid in two parts, at the beginning of each semester or at the beginning of any two quarters.

Scholarships can be withdrawn at any time upon the recommendation of the student's designated post-high school institution. The original scholarship award must be used within a four-year time period beginning from the date of the original award. The original award recipient may apply for an extension through Jana Eaton in the Administration office. Kiwanis will review each extension request. The scholarship is renewable to past scholarship winners who meet all the criteria. All applications can be acquired from the scholarship page on the website or from Jana Eaton in the Administration Office.

The selection committee may make exceptions to the application procedure.
