The superintendent briefed the Board on the following topics:

Annual School Self Assessment under the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act - Score of 92% (72 out of 78):

Self Assess on HIB policies and procedures. Areas of strength include following investigation timelines and HIB programs including Responsive Classroom and special events. Areas for growth identified were formal schedule of meetings for our school safety team and deeper analysis of issues that have a negative impact on school culture.

This year some new initiatives to strengthen school culture and minimize HIB include: restructuring of guidance counselor assignments, increase in extracurricular offerings, additional training for School Safety Team Members, team building activities on monthly Spirit Days.

A presentation on HIB from our board attorney is planned for our November meeting.

There are some significant mandated changes to HIB policies and procedures for this school year, including the use of uniform paperwork by all districts in New Jersey and a new regulation that requires that a report of a confirmed HIB incident becomes part of a student's permanent record. The inclusion of a confirmed HIB as part of a student's permanent record is not retro-active and applies to any confirmed HIB during the 2022-23 school

year and beyond. Additionally, while principals have always had discretion as to whether or not to investigate an alleged HIB, documentation of each case where discretion is used and a case is not investigated is required.

The Week of Respect:

Will be held in all New Jersey public schools next week. This is an opportunity to highlight the importance of working together and treating each other with respect and kindness. Please keep an eye out for correspondences from our program principals regarding special activities for the week.

Spirit Day:

The first district wide Spirit Day will be held this Friday, September 30th. Dr. Abraham and Mr. Scherer are working on activities to bring all of our K-8 students together as one team on each of Spirit Days. We ask that students wear their new NPS t-shirts on our Spirit Days to show off school pride and spirit.

Start Strong Assessment:

A standardized assessment required by the State of New Jersey that will be administered to all students in Grades 4-8 during the week of October 10th. This assessment provides information on student mastery of the previous grade levels standards and helps inform instruction for the current school year.

Mobile App Availability:

A reminder that the district has a mobile application available in the Google Play and Apple Stores. The app is an easy way to access school information in a user-friendly format.
