


2022 HMPS Summer Reading List Grades 6-8



Reading Level: 4.3




Summary: Charlie Hernandez and the League of Shadows by Ryan Calejo


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
Summary: The Playbook: 52 Rules to Aim, Shoot, and Score in this Game Called Life by Kwame Alexander
