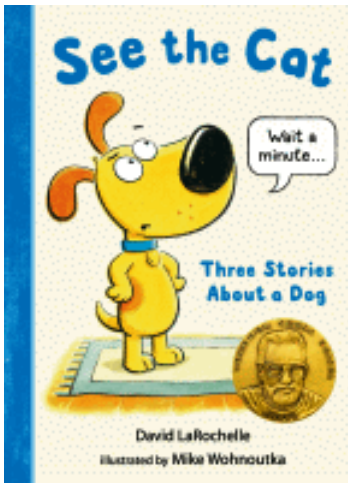




## 2022 HMPS Summer Reading List Grades K-1st

Summary: See the Cat by David LaRochelle



In this humorous early reader, three stories feature a dog named Max who doesn't agree with the narrator's account of the story. In the first, the narrator asks the reader to "see the cat." Max tries to correct the narrator, explaining that he's the only one on the page--until, to Max's surprise--the other characters eventually show up. In the second and third stories, Max must figure a way out of dangerous situations foretold by the narrator.

Reading Level: 1.2

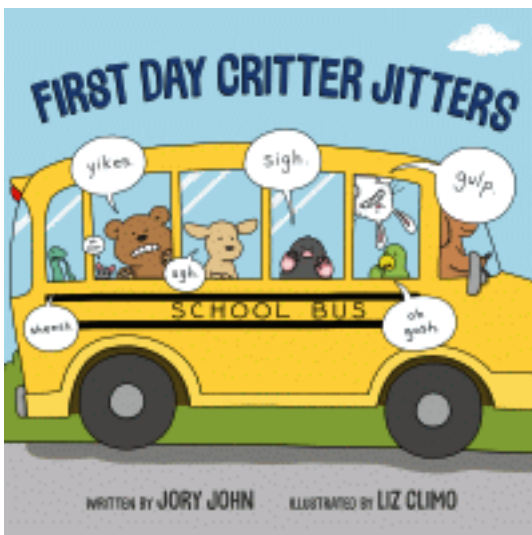
Resumen: Eva y Bebe Mo por Rebecca Elliott

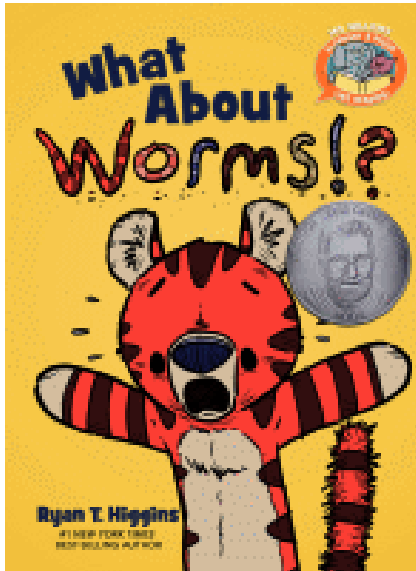

But when the animals arrive in class, they see their teacher, an armadillo, is nervous like them and won't come out of his ball shape. The animals offer to help their teacher and one another so that the day goes well.

### Summary: What About Worms!?! by Ryan Higgins

Tiger unwittingly helps some worms overcome their fear of tigers with a well-placed, informative book, but will a wormy hug aid a fearful Tiger?

Tiger is BIG. Tiger is BRAVE. And Tiger is NOT afraid of anything . . . except WORMS! Are Tiger's worm worries worse than worms?

Reading Level: 1.6



### Summary: Up on Bob by Mary Sullivan

Bob the dachshund works hard to make his bed as comfy as possible for his afternoon nap, but as he works, a cat slowly appears. With a great flourish the cat pounces on top of Bob, who tolerantly lets the cat sleep next to him in their perfect comfy bed.

Reading Level: 0.9



### Summary: The Yawns are Coming by Christopher Eliopoulos

A young boy and his best friend Noodles are having a sleepover and plan to stay up all night. When darkness hits, the boy realizes the yawns are coming after Noodles, and not long after a doze and snores attack him. When a sleepie attacks the boy, the activities they both planned for the night are postponed until morning.
