## **Course Description**

Introduction to Theatre is a one-semester Fine Arts class, wherein students become acquainted with various areas of theatre: acting, movement, vocalization, technology, etiquette, make-up, playwriting, literacy/terminology, and basic theatre history. Students gain a general knowledge of theatre arts and an appreciation of theatre as an enjoyable and important field of study. In-class performance and active class participation will be expected. Students are assessed through performances and projects, in terms of both end product and in-process preparation.
