### **Operations Update**

- Bus Operations

### **Instructional Program**

#### <u>Curriculum Implementation: ReadyMath</u>

- Principals will receive feedback on building implementation.

#### **School Culture Updates**

- At the beginning of the year, reported incidents had decreased by approximately 88% when compared to the 2017-2018 school year.
- In October 2018, SLLIS had 67% fewer incidents than in October 2017.
- In November 2018, SLLIS had 82% fewer incidents than in November 2017.
- In December 2018, SLLIS had 62% fewer incidents than in December 2017.

#### **Gomez and Gomez Implementation**

- Walkthroughs and monitoring resume this week and will rely on updated implementation plans.
- Program Liaisons will provide weekly updates to Executive Director and Principal regarding implementation progress.

#### **Instructional Team 2019**

- Instructional Team will allow SLLIS Leadership to oversee all programs: Dual Language, PBIS, Tiered Systems, Benchmark Advance, and ReadyMath.
- Data-driven approach will improve monitoring of all programs.
