



Yellow-Jackets

On September 5, 2014 Alex and I encountered a nest of yellow-jackets in the concession stand 8 inches in diameter near the wooden ladder to the crow's nest upstairs. Alex went upstairs first with a handful of equipment and there was no sign of a nest and came back down, I then went up the ladder and out they came. Neither one of us had seen the nest because it was partially hidden in the wall. Alex made it out without being stung but I received one small bite on the arm.

With the booster club, the score clock people and paramedic staff showing up in less than two hours the nest was sprayed with Enforcer "Wasp and Hornet Killer" E.P.A. Registration # 40849-77. I purchased the spray from Frink's Hardware Store. After spraying the nest I immediately contacted the Superintendent Jack Thompson to inform him of the situation and what had taken place. My concern was that I knew that one of the concession stand helpers was hyper-sensitive to chemicals and could be allergic to the Wasp and Hornet killer spray. The Superintendent made the decision that the booster club would not be allowed to use the building. Jack contacted the booster club and informed them of the situation and the precautions we were taking. I informed Jack that I had hosed out the entire building, washing the nest out along with washing the entire building out of any residue of the spray. Protocol dictates in our I.P.M. plan that I take preventative measures so this does not happen again. I used caulking to fill the outside access to the nest so they do not come back.

The booster club and score clock people had no incidents that evening with any yellow-jackets in the building. Because of the quick action we took, no one was harmed by the yellow-jackets or the chemicals used to kill them. This situation was handled in accordance to our District's I.P.M. plan when there is an emergency and life-safety is at stake. All parties that needed to be notified of the application were notified and preventative measures were taken. I also contacted the State Director of I.P.M. to ask if I had followed protocol and what could I do different next time. Mr. Stock told me that in the situation that I found myself in, the proper measures had been taken only because it was an emergency.
