- 2017-2018 Smarter Balance Scores
  - 24% met or exceeded in English Language Arts
  - 18% met or exceeded in math
  - 64% were at grade level according to the DRA
- Team in place for a new Continuous Improvement Plan to support our students getting to grade level



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# Title I-A Program

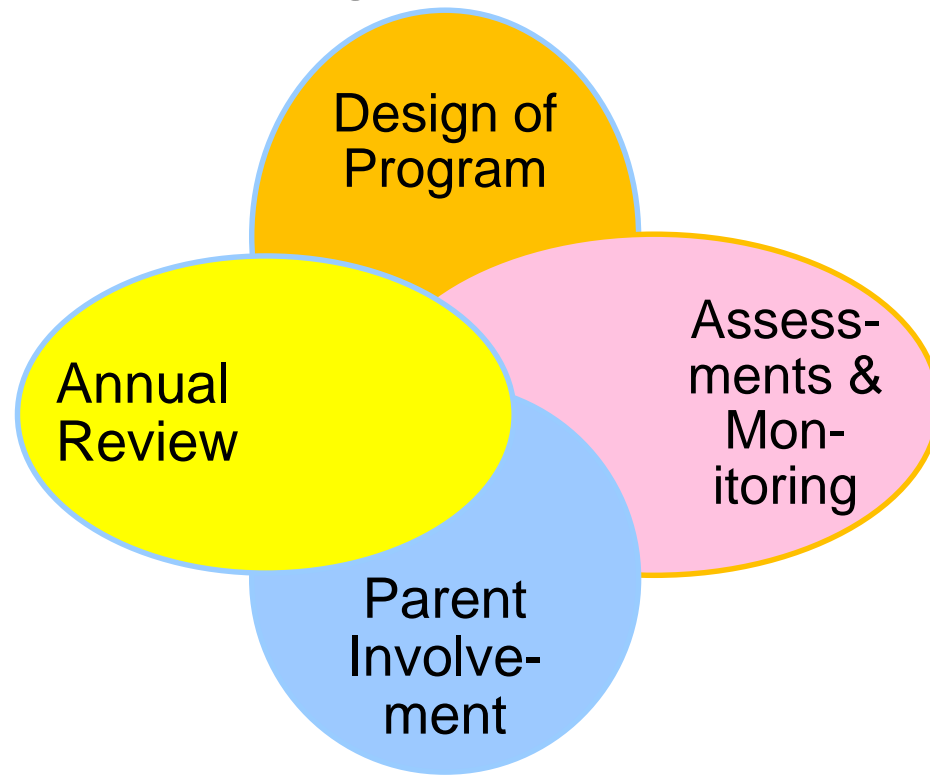
- What is “Title I-A”?
  - Title I-A is United States Government’s largest education assistance program for schools.
  - Funds are used to provide programs to help children who are struggling in reading and math.
  - Extra help (in addition to what they learn during math and reading time in the classroom)
  - Funding provided under ESEA

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# Design of our Program

- Schoolwide Program
  - Schoolwide – all students
  - Any student enrolled in the school can access our program
- What does our program look like?
  - Pull-out intervention program for students who are struggling
  - Push-in aide time
  - New books to help support our students
  - New assessment schedule to help determine student needs



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# Assessments & Monitoring

- Assessments our school uses:
  - Smarter Balance (SBAC)/OAKS
  - Developmental Reading Assessment (DRA)
  - Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills (DIBELS)
- Notification of your child's assessment results
  - SBAC scores sent home at the beginning of the year
  - DRA scores shared at conferences
- Progress monitoring process
  - Progress monitor every three weeks for intensive and strategic students
  - Meet with teachers to discuss and adjust groups



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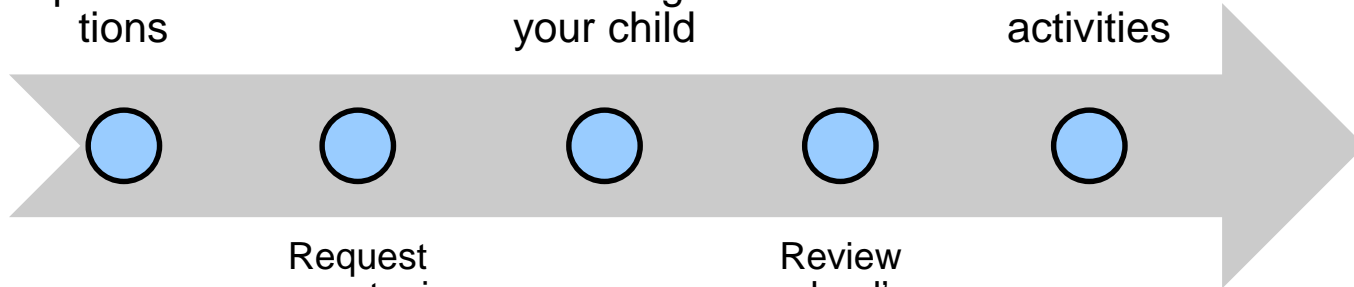
