
General Comments:

- <u>Bid date is moved to Thursday May 14, 2020 at 4PM</u>. Informal bids on proposal forms provided shall by <u>email only</u> to <u>askpurchasing@bcsemail.org</u>. There will be no public bid opening for the project. For questions regarding bid procedures contact Tiffany McCants, Purchasing Supervisor at the Central Office of Buncombe County Schools by email: tiffany.mccants@bcsemail.org.
- For questions regarding the design contact Timothy Fierle, AIA, BCS Facilities Director at tim.fierle@bcsemail.org.
- Completion date is moved to July 13, 2020.
- The project will be awarded and contracted by a BCS Purchase Order. Bonds are not required for the project.
- This is a turn-key project.
- An Allowance of \$5,000 for discoveries shall be included in the base bid and its use authorized by the Owner for benefit of the project. If any portion of the Discoveries Allowance is not used, it shall be "paid short" on the Purchase Order.

- The project will be permitted thru the Buncombe County Building Dept.
 Drawings have been submitted for plan review but contractor is responsible to
 complete the permit application, pay for review and permit fees and pickup the
 permit.
- Contractors and Subcontractors may visit the project during regular working hours 9AM -4PM Mon-Friday but avoid 11:30 to 1PM due to heavy traffic for the community feeding site. It is advisable to call ahead to the school (828) 274-7515 to ensure access and to alert the limited staff. Request access by buzzing in at the front entry. The custodian can open the rooms that house the electrical panels. If no access to the interior of the school is required, contractors and subcontractors may visit without visiting the office first.
- Provide any RFIs that require an Addendum no later than Monday May 11 at noon.
- Steel railings shall be shop primed and painted utilizing Sherwin Williams Industrial Enamel or approved equal paint product, 2 finish coats. HDG after fabrication is not required.
- Steel railings shall be provided with expansion joints at maximum <u>20 ft</u> intervals and shall be shown on shop drawings for review and approval. Avoid cutting, welding and priming railings in the field to the greatest extent possible.
- Concrete walk and ramp finishes shall be "picture framed", finished with a light broom finish perpendicular to the direction of travel and have tooled joints at 5' intervals.
- UGL Drylock Fastplug is an approved substitute as a hydraulic anchoring cement.
- Note attached drawings of 1st and 2nd floors providing routing of low voltage cabling between the Area of rescue controls and Comm panel in the Main office. Rated walls shall be firestopped and all cabling shall be supported independently by "J" hooks at max 3'6" OC. Power and low voltage cabling shall be routed above ceiling concealed to the greatest extent possible.
- The routing for low voltage cabling and for electrical power is primarily above lay-in ceilings except for the main lobby where a perimeter of hard ceilings are found- see diagrams.


