Addendum # 3

12- FAIRVIEW ELEMENTARY RE-ROOFING

Roofing system at Roof Area N:

1. Provide a fully adhered .060 EPDM membrane over 2 layers 1 1/2" polyisocyanurate insulation.
2. Top layer of insulation to be 25 psi.
3. Lower layer to fit tightly between 1 1/4" high metal roof standing seams.
4. Insulation joints to be offset 12" in both directions.
5. Insulation to be mechanically fastened to existing metal roof.
6. Provide pull testing to verify fastening required to meet FM 1-60 and manufacturer's 15 year, 72mph full system warranty. Also provide manufacturer's 20 year membrane warranty.
7. At transition from ballasted roof to metal roof overlay: Provide 2" backer rod under membrane between the systems' base securement for membrane expansion.
8. At ridge: Secure insulation and new membrane. Provide new 24 gauge pre-finished metal flashing, and re-secure existing ridge metal.
9. At wall: Terminate per detail 12/A501.1
10. At transition to existing metal roof: Provide term bar and water block adhesive.
11. Roof system manufacturer to be the same as the ballasted roof.

12. Provide manufacturer's approved details for complete system installation with shop drawing submittal.
13. Second revised proposal form is attached.
