

SUMMER SCHOOLS

The Board may approve the use of school facilities for summer sessions for students who need developmental, remedial or make-up work in basic skills. These sessions may also include courses designed for enrichment and can carry credit if the proper number of hours in attendance is maintained.

Students may be charged tuition but most summer programs will be offered at no cost to the student.

All summer programs will be subject to approval by the Board.
