To create and maintain a safe, orderly and inviting learning environment, students must have the skills to resolve conflicts in non-violent ways.

All schools are encouraged and any alternative school is required to include a conflict resolution strategy in the school improvement plan as provided in policy 3430, School Improvement Plans.

The appropriate central curriculum committee shall explore opportunities to integrate conflict resolution skills into the current state wide instructional standards and other curricula.
