UNAUTHORIZED USE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY

Property owned by the Buncombe County Board of Education may not be used for private purposes except as allowed by Board Policy #5030—Community Use of School Facilities.

Recreational conveyances are prohibited on Buncombe County School property.

The Buncombe County Board of Education prohibits unauthorized operation of recreational conveyances on all property of the Buncombe County Schools. This prohibition shall not apply to any person operating any motor vehicle as a means of transportation to or from any regular session of the school and any school sponsored and supervised activity during non-school hours.

Any employee of the Buncombe County Board of Education and any other person observing the operation of recreational conveyances on the property of the Buncombe County Board of Education, contrary to the provisions of this policy or contrary to the laws of the State of North Carolina, should make a complaint known to the proper law enforcement officers of the County of Buncombe.

The term "recreational conveyances" shall encompass mini-bikes, motorcycles, go-carts, ATV's, and other motorized vehicles, plus skateboards, rollerblades, in-line skates, sleds, skis, and any other means of transportation that may result in damage to school property or endanger the health and well-being of the user.
