OFFER VERSUS SERVE PROVISION OF THE NATIONAL LUNCH PROGRAM

"Offer Versus Serve" is an amendment to the nutritional requirements of the school lunch program. It is a serving method designed to reduce food waste and food cost in the school lunch program without jeopardizing the nutritional integrity of the lunches served. It allows students to decline a food item that they do not plan to eat that would normally be a component of the complete lunch. The price of the lunch to the student, however, is not reduced, nor is the nutritional integrity of the meal.

"Offer Versus Serve" is adopted as policy in all Buncombe County Schools.
