

NAMING SCHOOL PROPERTIES

Board of Education Policy 9300 specifically outlines a procedure to be followed when naming a “*new school facility*.” From time to time facilities other than “*new school facilities*” may be recommended for naming. These facilities may include, but are not limited to, libraries, ball fields, stadiums, gymnasiums, and tracks. Naming of these facilities, whether new or old, will require that a recommendation be made to the superintendent. Recommendations may be received from interested individuals in a similar manner outlined in the Board’s policy. The superintendent will determine the appropriateness of the recommendation and shall inform the Board of Education of his recommendation. With the Board's informal approval, the superintendent shall authorize the naming.
