How do school nurses serve students? School Nurses...

- See students with illnesses, injuries, rashes, asthma, diabetes, chronic conditions, and other health concerns.
- Talk to parents about health related questions or concerns. The school nurse can help develop a health plan for your child while they are at school.
- Teach school staff about chronic health concerns, special health care tasks, and medication administration.
- Train school staff to manage daily health care needs of students.
- Screen for vision and dental problems and assure students receive needed care.
- Advise schools and parents on childhood shots and diseases.
- Teach health education classes such as hygiene, growth and development, nutrition and physical activity and others many others.
