What is Every Child?

The Arc of NC and The YMCA of WNC share the belief that Every Child, regardless of differences, should have the same opportunities for high quality, safe and fun afterschool programming.

Most children who are different just need a little extra help and supervision. We provide small-group supervision of 2 adults working with no more than 5 children. Our thorough intake & screening process will ensure that your child is kept safe and happy. Our small groups are fully integrated into the typical YMCA afterschool program schedule. If neither the small group nor the overall program is a good fit for your child, there are other options we can discuss.

All Buncombe County and Asheville City YMCA afterschool sites serving 23 county and 5 city elementary schools. If your child attends a Buncombe County or Asheville City elementary school, we have a program available for you!
