PE dept. requests that cheating policy not affect athletics/sports participation. CTE dept. agrees with "high stakes vs. low stakes" with teachers dealing with low stakes and administration dealing with high stakes

4. Tami Ramsey – preliminary report for SMART lunches:

S- students

M – maximize

A – achievement

R - relationships

T – time

Several NC schools participate with a lunch A/B. Time is used for mandatory referrals, club time, one on one tutoring, etc. Number of tutorials is shown on progress reports and makes students more responsible for their own learning. Intramurals/use of weight room, off campus lunch privileges could be available for A/B students. PLCs could also meet during this time. At risk students would have more time with teachers. Every school (but one) saw an increase in academics and graduation rates.

We will continue to explore SMART lunches; thanks to Tami Ramsey for researching information discussed. Lots of questions; our plans are to plan next school year for SMART lunches to begin year 2015-2016.
