## **CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

Each participating student will be required to visit the Memorial Wall which is located at the American Legion grounds in Hopedale, Ohio.

Essays are to be 200 words or more and original, describing your interpretation of Wall. Your essay will be judged for its content and originality.

ALL essays must be typed. No hand written essays will be accepted.

Artwork is to be at least 11 1/2 by 14 in sizes. Any medium is acceptable (pen, pencil, pastels, watercolors, computer imaging, etc). Interpretation of Wall should be portrayed in art rendition.

Drawings of the wall itself will be disqualified. Portions of Wall however, may be used in artwork.

## Picture of student visit to Wall <u>"must"</u> accompany entry for Scholarship consideration.

Guidance Counselor has a map to the Memorial. Please request a copy. ALL entries must be postmarked no later than Friday, April 30 2019 and "must" be mailed by guidance counselor to be considered.
