

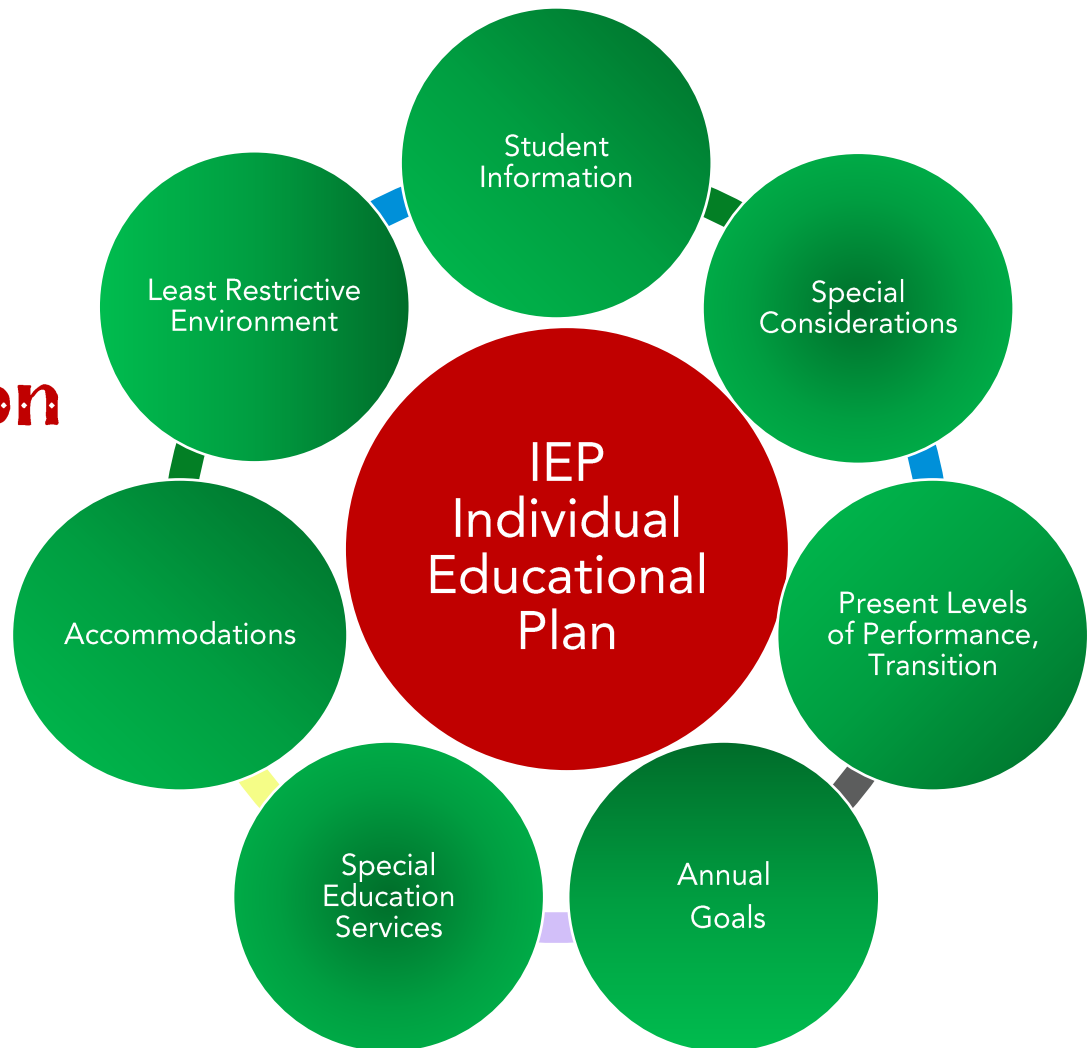

What Information is in the IEP?



How Can I Participate in the IEP Meeting?

- Research your child's disability.
- Share your goals for your child for this school year and for years to come.
- Talk about what your child is good at doing and in what areas they need help.
- Discuss the services and accommodations your child is currently receiving and decide if they are needed, should be increased, or decreased.
- Ask questions whenever you do not understand.
- Know your child's current goals and if they are being met.
