The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) includes several parental involvement requirements. One of those is that all districts within the State understand and comply with the requirement to notify parents in Title I schools when their children are assigned to or are being taught by a teacher who did not meet state certification in a core academic subject for four or more consecutive weeks.
