Scotts Valley Unified School District School Driver Rules

FOR ALL DRIVERS FOR SCHOOL FUNCTIONS, SPORTING EVENTS AND FIELD TRIPS

- All events must originate from the school and follow the safest, most direct route to and from the destination with no unnecessary stops. Early out days are NO exception; departure must be from the school.
- Before transporting students on any field trip or activity, drivers shall register with the school site office.
- All student passengers shall provide permission slips signed by their parents/guardians.
- At the end of the event the student must return with the same driver. If parents want their student to be released to them after the event, the parent must get permission from the teacher, coach, staff member and confirm with the driver that permission was granted.
- Absolutely NO drivers under the age of 21 (twenty-one).
- Drivers shall be required to possess a valid California driver's license and liability insurance of at least \$100K per person/\$300K per occurrence/\$50K property damage. Owners, drivers and passengers shall be informed that the registered owner and his/her insurance company are responsible for any accidents that may occur. District personnel who frequently transport students in their private vehicle are also required to carry liability insurance of \$100K per person/\$300K per occurrence/\$50K property damage. All drivers must be a coach, teacher, staff member, parent or parental designated person such as grandparent or sibling over the age of 21 (twenty-one) with a completed *Driver Registration Form* with the following documentation attached and on file in the school office prior to transporting any students:
 - 1. Current proof of insurance (declarations page showing liability limits)
 - 2. Valid California driver's license (I understand the district may obtain a copy of my driving record from the Department of Motor Vehicles.)
 - 3. Vehicle registration
- All drivers and passengers shall wear seat belts in accordance with the law (Vehicle Code 27315, 27360, 27360.5, 27363). I agree to 1) follow the safest, most direct route to the destination; 2) avoid unnecessary stops; 3) transport only authorized passengers, no guests; 4)transport no more than 10 persons, including the driver (education code 38045); 5) require all occupants to wear seat belts; 6) not seat a child who is 12 years old or younger in the front seat of a car with a passenger side airbag; 7) use a booster or car seat, located in the rear seat of the vehicle, for any child who is under 8 years of age unless they are 4 feet 9 inches or taller.) Parents must provide booster or car seats for the child.
- In case of emergency, keep all students together and call 911 and the school site/district office.
- No one may smoke a pipe, cigar, or cigarette while there are minors in the vehicle, as required by law. (SB 7 Health and Safety Code 118947-118949)
- The site administrator has the discretionary right to refuse participation of any driver without prior notification.
