SVUSD Photo Permission Form

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), a federal law, requires that Scotts Valley Unified School District, with certain exceptions, obtain your written consent prior to the disclosure of personally identifiable information of students. However, the district may disclose appropriately designated identifiable student information without written consent, unless you have advised the district to the contrary in accordance with district procedures. The primary purpose of directory information is to allow the district to include this type of information regarding your student in certain school and/or district publications. Examples include:

- A playbill, showing your child's role in a drama production
- The annual yearbook
- Honor roll or other recognition lists
- Graduation programs
- Sports activity sheets, such as for wrestling, show weight and height of team members

Schools and the District seek parent permission to publish photos, videos, and learning projects of SVUSD students. As you are aware, there are potential dangers associated with the posting of personally identifiable information on a web site since global access to the Internet does not allow us to control who may see such information. These dangers have always existed; however, we as schools do want to celebrate your child and his/her work. The law requires that we ask for your permission to use particular information about your child.
