NEW SHOREHAM SCHOOL DISTRICT BLOCK ISLAND SCHOOL

The facilities and equipment of this district represent a significant investment by the taxpayers and their maintenance is a prime concern of the School Committee. The Superintendent is responsible for ensuring that there is an ongoing program of organizing an inventory of equipment and for the maintenance and upkeep of the building, its fixtures, and capital equipment.

The School Department shall maintain the physical plant and equipment by a continuous program of repair, reconditioning, and remodeling. As part of the annual budget, the Superintendent shall propose to the School Committee funds for the preventive maintenance of all facilities. The Superintendent shall provide on an annual basis to the Town of New Shoreham a report relating to future capital improvements for the school department as well as a report concerning the condition of the school buildings and grounds.

Adequate grounds shall be maintained for the educational and recreational programs of the school children and the overall requirements for providing such grounds shall be continually reviewed.

The School Committee also recognizes the value of attractive landscaping consistent with economy in cost and operation. The students and community shall be encouraged to participate in the beautification of school grounds.

On at least a quarterly basis, the Superintendent shall report to the School Committee on the School Department's ongoing maintenance needs and progress on addressing those needs.
