

Title: ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SUMMER READING POLICY

Purpose: The goal of the summer reading policy is to continue, reinforce, and expand upon reading skills during the summer recess. The purpose is to have students continue to read and write on a regular basis throughout the year.

Policy: Teaching faculty will annually recommend a listing of age/grade appropriate books that will be adopted into an approved summer reading list for each grade level. A list of ten or more books per grade will be compiled to allow for a variety of interests and reading abilities.

Students entering grades one through six will be asked to read as many books as possible during the summer recess. Students will be required to submit a reading record sheet signed by parents listing books read during the summer. Using selections from the provided grade lists students will be required to represent two books in project form. These projects will be submitted during the first week of school.
