Title: EXAMINATION PERIOD OPEN CAMPUS

NEW SHOREHAM SCHOOL DISTRICT BLOCK ISLAND SCHOOL

High school students, grades 8-12, shall be afforded open campus privileges during the midyear and final examination periods subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Student(s) arrive for scheduled examinations on time.
- 2. Student(s) leaving before the end of the school day must sign out (on the office sign-out sheet).
- 3. Upon signing out, student(s) must immediately leave the school building and grounds. Student(s) returning for an afternoon exam must sign in at the office upon arrival.
- 4. Student(s) intending to arrive after the regularly scheduled start of the school day shall have notified, the office staff by 8:30 a.m. that they intend to be in as scheduled for the examination(s), must sign-in at the main office upon arrival, and must be at their assigned test site on time.
- 5. All interim time(s) will be spent in quiet student halls or in "brush-up" sessions with faculty members.
- 6. Student(s) arriving after the regularly scheduled start of the school and/or those leaving prior to the end of the regular school day shall be responsible for their own transportation.

It is further understood that the examination open campus provision is a privilege that must be earned and maintained. Any student who fails to abide by the prescribed conditions, or who fails to exhibit appropriate conduct, may have this privilege revoked.
